





#### ON-TIME GRADUATION Students earning a diploma within four years. Cohort includes students who were first-time




#### **School Goals**

## REGULAR ATTENDERS


Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.



#### **Academic Progress**


#### **ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE**

Students earning a high school diploma or GED within five years.




#### **State Goals**




#### ADVANCED COURSEWORK

2-12 Math and Science enrichment services, dual credit, and college credit online programs allow each student to set their own course and pace for learning.


#### CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION
