



### School Environment


#### CLASS SIZE

#### REGULAR ATTENDERS


Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

#### ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE


Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.



### Academic Success


#### ON-TIME GRADUATION

Students earning a diploma within four years. Cohort includes students who were first-time ninth graders in 2014-15.




#### FIVE-YEAR COMPLETION

As a rural charter school serving a diverse student population our focus is on meeting students where they are at and maximizing achievement growth. Our high teacher/educator to student ratios mean that our students are paired with a variety of competent, caring and capable adults who are dedicated to creating a welcoming learning environment.

### State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2025. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

### Safe & Welcoming Environment

Small, STEAM focused elementary classes, diverse and flexible middle/high school scheduling, a family atmosphere and lots of capable caring, competent adults working with small groups of students serves to facilitate a safe, warm learning environment.
