- Call to Order, Flag Salute at 1900
- 2. Approval of Agenda

Deb Lindberg motioned to approve the agenda as presented. Linda Montanez seconded. All in favor. Motion passed unanimously.

- 6. Teacher Report No teachers in attendance
 - A. The teachers had a union meeting that they invited Aaron Schneider and Ron Koetz to attend their meeting.
 - B. Staff have expressed to Deb Lindberg that space needs to be used more efficiently, specifically space being held by non-employees who have assigned space where some employees still need space. Aaron Schneider responded that this was a common thread in the employee surveys.
- 7. Superintendent's Report Marc Thielman
 - A. Marc Thielman wanted to give kudos to Terry Lunsford and Jody Cantrell for their work on the vaccine bill at the state legislature.
 - B. Marc Thielman attended the OSAA general counsel meeting. He brought back that OSAA will continue with 6-man football. He also mentioned that the OSAA is considering adding E-Sports [i.e. video games]. OSAA is looking at classifications. There are lots of strange things going on around desire to change classifications depending on skill level. Being at the 1A level, this probably won't be great for our programs.

D. Spring Sports Update:

- i. HS Track: Track is in full swing; the kids have already had 5 meets and compete in the Prefontaine Rotary Invitational tomorrow. So far, they have done very well and most everyone has PR'd so far this season.
- ii. MS Track: tonight, is their first meet due to the canceling of several events due to flooding. We've had 16 kids out so far and a few others have expressed interest in joining.

E. Other News:

- I will be attending the 2019 AD Conference April 12th-16th and we will be having our league meeting during that time. We will have our schedules out for next year when I return.
- ii. We also need to go ahead on hiring a new football coach. There are 8-10 boys that are interested in playing, but I haven't had any of them sign a commitment contract yet.

9. Discussion Items

- A. Financial Update Our State School Funding has been updated, which means more money coming in. Our ending fund balance is looking a lot healthier this month. Katie Sapp mentioned that transportation costs are way up, especially non-reimbursable mileage. The board discussed keeping our transportation program robust is good for the district. Deb Lindberg stated that we need to be mindful of costs to make sure we can afford what we are doing.

- C. Every Student Succeeds Act Funding Katie Sapp handed out information on this grant.
- D. 2019-2020 Calendar Katie Sapp handed out three options. Marc Thielman and Katie Sapp. Aaron Schneider said that the teachers would like to have the middle ground calendar but would like to see us start a week later and have a shorter spring break. Katie Sapp pointed out that would be a totally different calendar from what is presented as the semesters would have to be adjusted and change everything. Aaron Schneider mentioned that the teachers were willing to try something new.
- E. 2019-2020 Athletic Teams The board discussed football season. Shirley Koetz surveyed students today during advisory and eight students said they for sure would like to play next year. Katie Sapp mentioned that last year the board stated that we need 10 students to start a football season. Marc Thielman stated that we are making headway, but we aren't there yet. Nicole Davis will work over the next month to get a list of committed kids and make sure that they know that they must be eligible.

The architect was here today and went through the house with Keenan Elbers and Marc Thielman and will have a plan for the house next week. Shirley Koetz has been working with Consumers Power to look at power savings options in the house. The board felt that the house was the highest priority. We can discuss the rest after the house is done.
